Declaration of Quorum/Disclosures of Potential Conflicts of Interest: A quorum was confirmed. This meeting was conducted via Microsoft TEAMS. Ms. Odewumi confirmed that the notice providing the time, date and teleconferencing information was duly posted. **<u>Ratify Interim Bill.com Payments Totaling \$55,362.55</u>**:Mr. Wilson noted the BRE DDR needs to change from \$19,599.72 to \$33,347.22 updating the total amount for approval to \$69,110.65. Following discussion and review, upon a motion duly made by Director Sheppard, seconded by Director Berg, and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the Board approved the interim bill.com payments totaling \$69, 110.65 as presented.
